Dental X-Ray Positioning

Dental X-Rays are more like an art than a science

I teach using landmarks and not geometry to make learning easier

Live powerpoint (1 hour)

Radiation safety

X-ray orientation - Left, right, upper, lower

Pictures and description of every angle & troubleshooting tips
